

The Sierra College wrestling team went into the Northern California Regional tournament as the number two ranked team but at the end of the day the Wolverines left no notice that they are ready to make a run for another state title by winning a nor cal regional championship. The Wolverines had many outstanding performances. Sierra had 7 wrestlers reach the finals and came away with 5 champions. Brandon Benvenuti had the top performance of the day by pinning every wrestler that he faced and with that he was named the most outstanding wrestler of the regional tournament. Mike Vassar had one of the most exiting matches of the tournament with his overtime victory over the number one ranked wrestler. Vlad Dombrovskiy dominated his finals match with an 8-3 victory to earn his first regional title. Jesus Chavez had one of his best tournaments of the year and in the finals he defeated the number one ranked wrestler 6-4 for his first regional title. Ryan Scarr who has not wrestled much this year due to injury had one of the most impressive tournaments of the day. Ryan won in the semi match 12-9 and then 6-4 in his finals match to win his first regional title for the Wolverines. The biggest blow to the sierra college team came at 133 where number one ranked wrestler Norman Richmond was injured in the finals and settled for second place. Aaron Pickard battled injuries all tournament but still managed to have a great day and placed third to qualify for the state championship. Nick Gill qualified for the state tournament by placing second losing a close match to the number one ranked wrestler 9-4. Sierra also had Bruce Arndt placed sixth and Kavon Tillotson placed seventh. The Wolverines will next be in action Friday December 11th at Chabot College in Hayward at the California State Championships.
